



Acceptable Voter Identification:

The following chart outlines acceptable proof of identity and residence that you must bring to your voting place:

One piece of ID showing your **Name** and **Qualifying Address** (an original, or a certified or notarial copy, of a document listed below)

- Ontario driver's licence
- Ontario Health Card (photo card)
- Ontario Photo Card
 - Ontario motor vehicle permit (vehicle portion)
- Cancelled personalized cheque
- Mortgage statement, lease or rental agreement relating to property in Ontario
- Insurance policy or insurance statement
- Loan or financial agreement with a financial institution
- Document issued or certified by a court in Ontario
- An income tax assessment notice
- Child Benefit Tax statement
- Any other document from the Government of Canada, Ontario or a municipality in Ontario or from an agency of such a government
- Any document from a Band Council in Ontario established under the *Indian Act* (Canada)
- Statement of Employment Insurance Benefits Paid T4E
- Statement of Old Age Security T4A (OAS)
- Statement of Canada Pension Plan Benefits T4A (P)
- Canada Pension Plan Statement of Contributions
- Statement of Direct Deposit for Ontario Works
- Statement of Direct Deposit for Ontario Disability Support Program
- Workplace Safety and Insurance Board Statement of Benefits T5007
- Property tax assessment
- Credit card statement, bank account statement, or RRSP, RRIF,RHOSP or T5 statement
- CNIB Card or a card from another registered charitable organization that provides service to persons with disabilities
- Hospital card or record
- Document showing campus residence, issued by that post office or officials responsible for student residence at a post-secondary institution
- Document showing residence in a long-term care home under the *Long Term Care Homes Act, 2007,* issued by the Administrator for the home
- Utility bill for hydro, water, gas, telephone or cable TV or a bill form a public utilities commission
- Cheque stub, T4 statement or pay receipt issued by an employer
- Transcript or report card from a post-secondary school

Alternatively, a person may complete an application in the prescribed form, including a statutory declaration that he or she is the elector shown on the voters' list.
