

## **Casual Reserve Crossing Guard Fire and By-Law Services**

Crossing Guards are responsible for preserving the safety of school children. This is a casual **“as needed”** position for times when a permanent crossing guard is unavailable to work and could lead to a full time crossing guard posting should a posting become available

Applicants must be able to communicate effectively with children; able to walk with the children; and have the agility to react to a potential hazard; demonstrate adequate vision and hearing levels; able to work outdoors during all seasons; and be able to arrive at point of duty for specified duty time. Reserve guards must be available to work limited hours and with short notice.

The successful candidates will have superior customer service skills and a positive attitude. A High School Diploma is an asset.

The position is being offered at an hourly rate of \$16.40.
