Dear Home Owner,

The Town of Pelham has contracted Norjohn Contracting for the road rehabilitation of Meadowvale Drive from Rolling Meadows Boulevard to Rolling Meadows Boulevard, Woodside Square from Welland Road to approximately 350 meters North, and Kevin Drive, from Haist Street up to and including Sherri-Lee Crescent.

Through the course of the project, work will be done consisting of milling of the existing pavement and placing new hot mix asphalt to improve the road cross-section, complete any required base repairs and, install new concrete isolation man-holes.

Due to the nature of the work being done, there may come a time when access to your respective property may be limited or blocked. In the event that this does occur, notices will be delivered in order to allow the homeowner to make the necessary preparations.

Should you or someone in your home have a medical condition or any reason why access to the property cannot be blocked, please contact the Town using the information provided on this notice.

Weather permitting, work is to commence on April 20, 2021 and should be substantially completed by April 28, 2021.
