

Vaccination clinics offered by Red Cross and GO-VAXX coming to the Meridian Community Centre in Pelham

Pelham, ON – The Meridian Community Centre in the Town of Pelham will be the site of three upcoming walk-in vaccination clinics.

The fully accessible GO-VAXX bus will be at the Meridian Community Centre Thursday, March 3 and Thursday, March 10, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. First and second dose Vaccines for aged five and up and boosters for those aged 12 and up will be offered. GO-VAXX mobile buses accept scheduled appointments through Ontario's booking portal, and walkins are also available.

The Canadian Red Cross will offer a walk-in indoor clinic on Saturday, March 5, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Moderna will be available from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m., and the Family Clinic for Pfizer for Adult and Pediatrics will run from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. No appointments are required.

The clinics are open to all Canadians and those visiting are reminded to:

- Bring your health card. If you do not have a health card or your health card is expired, bring another form of government-issued photo identification such as a driver's license, passport, status card or birth certificate.
- Dress for the weather in the event there is a lineup, especially those accessing the GO-VAXX bus.
- Wear clothing that allows easy access to the upper arm, such as a loose-fitting top or a T-shirt.
- Wear a mask that covers your nose, mouth and chin.
- Do not visit the clinics if you have symptoms of COVID-19.
