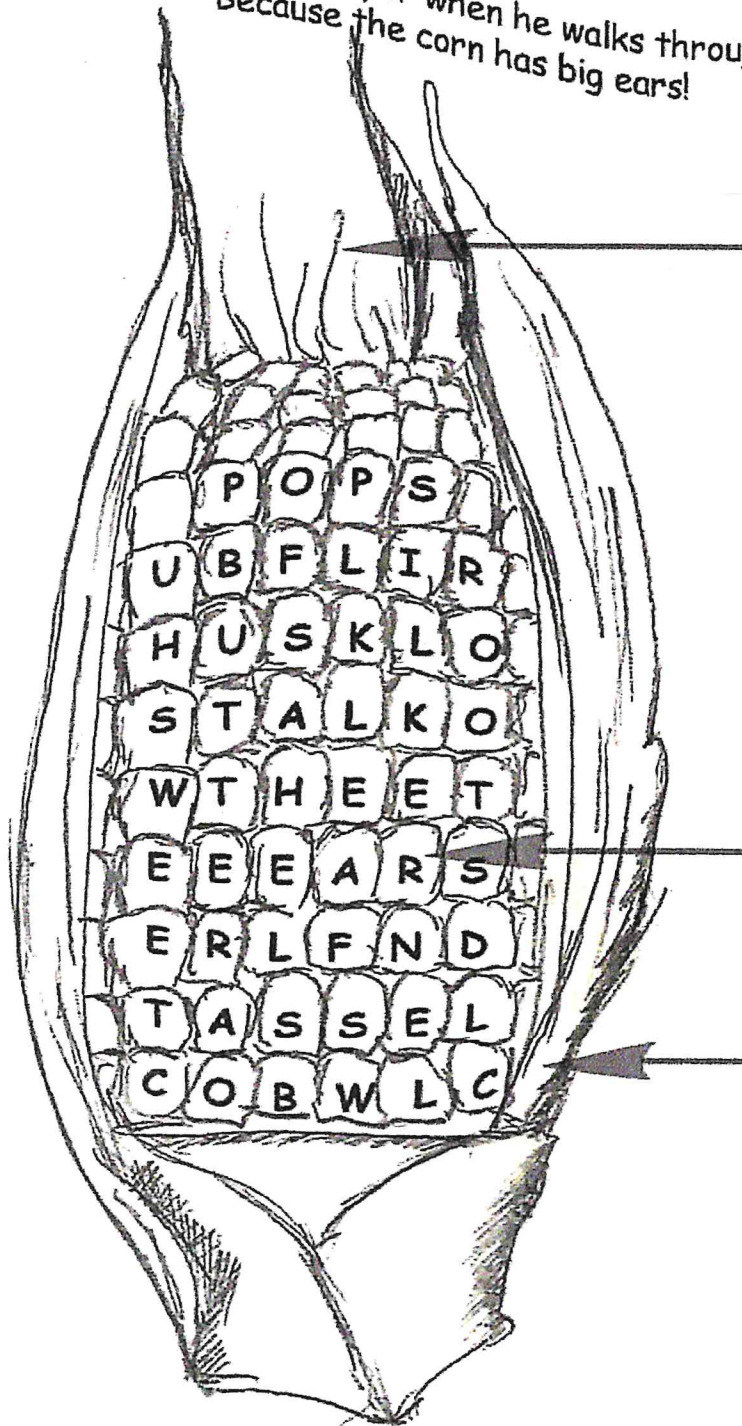


Do you have an ear for corn?
