### **Damage, Medical, and Photo Waiver**

I hereby release the Corporation of the Town of Pelham from all claims for damage arising from participation of the applicant during any program except where such damage or injury results from the negligence of the Town and/or its employees. Permission is hereby granted to the department and its representatives to transport my child to a local hospital for medical treatment if necessary. The Corporation of the Town of Pelham reserves the right to use photographs of my child participating in recreation programs for promotional purposes, without royalty rights.

### **Behaviour Contract and Waiver**

The Town of Pelham Camps do not tolerate violence or bad language. Campers are expected to show respect for both the staff and other campers. If this does not occur, the following action will be taken:

First Offence: Camper will be spoken to by a staff member. Parents/guardian will be told about the offence.

Second Offence: Camper and parent/guardian will be spoken to and reminded of the camp policy.

Third Offence: Parents/guardian will be requested to remove their child for the remainder of the camp. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.

Campers are asked not to bring unnecessary items to camp. This includes but is not limited to: Gameboys, ipods, cell phones, etc. If found these items will be confiscated and returned to the parents/guardian at the end of the day.

The applicant agrees to abide by all stated and written rules and regulations of the camp as administered by the Town of Pelham. The applicant agrees to abide by the rules of the leaders involved in the program. The applicant agrees to participate in the spirit of good sportsmanship at all times. Inability to maintain appropriate behavior, as deemed by the leaders of the camp, will result in the applicant's removal from camp.
