



**Acceptable Voter Identification:**

The following chart outlines acceptable proof of identity and residence that you must bring to your voting place:

One piece of ID showing your <b>Name</b> and <b>Qualifying Address</b> (an original, or a certified or notarial copy, of a document listed below)
• Ontario driver's licence
• Ontario Health Card (photo card)
• Ontario Photo Card
• Ontario motor vehicle permit (vehicle portion)
• Cancelled personalized cheque
• Mortgage statement, lease or rental agreement relating to property in Ontario
• Insurance policy or insurance statement
• Loan or financial agreement with a financial institution
• Document issued or certified by a court in Ontario
• An income tax assessment notice
• Child Benefit Tax statement
• Any other document from the Government of Canada, Ontario or a municipality in Ontario or from an agency of such a government
• Any document from a Band Council in Ontario established under the <i>Indian Act</i> (Canada)
• Statement of Employment Insurance Benefits Paid T4E
• Statement of Old Age Security T4A (OAS)
• Statement of Canada Pension Plan Benefits T4A (P)
• Canada Pension Plan Statement of Contributions
• Statement of Direct Deposit for Ontario Works
• Statement of Direct Deposit for Ontario Disability Support Program
• Workplace Safety and Insurance Board Statement of Benefits T5007
• Property tax assessment
• Credit card statement, bank account statement, or RRSP, RRIF, RHOSP or T5 statement
• CNIB Card or a card from another registered charitable organization that provides service to persons with disabilities
• Hospital card or record
• Document showing campus residence, issued by that post office or officials responsible for student residence at a post-secondary institution
• Document showing residence in a long-term care home under the <i>Long Term Care Homes Act, 2007</i> , issued by the Administrator for the home
• Utility bill for hydro, water, gas, telephone or cable TV or a bill from a public utilities commission
• Cheque stub, T4 statement or pay receipt issued by an employer
• Transcript or report card from a post-secondary school

Alternatively, a person may complete an application in the prescribed form, including a statutory declaration that he or she is the elector shown on the voters' list.

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
