Skate Patrol (Part-time)

Reporting directly to the Active Living Programmer and taking direction from Facilities Operations staff, the Skate Patrol staff are responsible for assisting in the maintenance of the Meridian Community Centre, equipment and ice surface and cleaning of the lobby, restrooms, rink, and all exterior and common areas in order to provide a welcoming and safe facility. The Skate Patrol staff are responsible for being a constant presence inside and outside the rink area during public skating events to deter any disruptive conduct and will assist with crowd control and provide general customer service. This position performs ice patrol functions to ensure patrons comply with the rules associated with public skating.

The successful candidate will possess the following:

- Strong interpersonal skills; capable of working with a diverse staff to achieve desired results professionally and efficiently.
- Superior customer service and positive attitude
- Valid First Aid and CPR certifications are considered an asset
- Must be able to skate and provide own skates
