

## Identification Requirements

The following chart outlines the acceptable forms of identification that electors must present at the voting place as proof of identity and residence. Electors are required to provide identification in accordance with the applicable election legislation.

One piece of ID showing your <b>Name</b> and <b>Qualifying Address</b> (an original, or a certified or notarial copy, of a document listed below)
✓ Ontario drivers' licence
✓ Ontario health card
✓ Ontario photo card
✓ Ontario motor vehicle permit
✓ Cancelled personalized cheque
✓ Mortgage statement, lease or rental agreement relating to property in Ontario
✓ Insurance policy or statement
✓ Loan or financial agreement with a financial institution
✓ Document issued or certified by a court in Ontario
✓ Income tax assessment notice
✓ Child benefit tax statement
✓ Any other document from the Government of Canada, Ontario, or a municipality in Ontario or from an agency of such government
✓ Any document from a Band Council in Ontario established under the <i>Indian Act</i> (Canada)
✓ Statement of Employment Insurance Benefits Paid T4E
✓ Statement of old age security T4A (OAS)
✓ Statement of Canada pension plan benefits T4A (P)
✓ Canada pension plan statement of contributions
✓ Statement of direct deposit for Ontario workers
✓ Statement of direct deposit for Ontario disability support program
✓ Workplace Safety and Insurance Board statement of benefits T5007
✓ Property tax assessment
✓ Credit card statement, bank account statement, or RRSP, RRIF, RHOSP, or T5 statement
✓ CNIB card or a card from another registered charitable organization that provides service to persons with disabilities
✓ Hospital card or record
✓ Documentation showing campus residence, issued by that post office or officials responsible for student residence at a post-secondary institution
✓ Document showing residence in a long-term care home under the <i>Long Term Care Homes Act, 2007</i> , issued by the Administrator for the home
✓ Utility bill for hydro, water, gas, telephone or cable TV or a bill form a public utilities commission
✓ Cheque stub, T4 statement, or pay receipt issued by an employer
✓ Transcript or report card from post-secondary school

Alternatively, a person may complete an application in the prescribed form, including a statutory declaration that they are the elector shown on the voters' list.
