


April 8 | Beginning at 2:00 pm Across Niagara Region

Mid April | Weather Dependant All urban roadways in Pelham

Sweepers will make two passes down each roadway with the mechanical sweeper and then another pass with the vacuum sweeper for the finer debris and material. Residents will see delays between passes as sweepers must empty their hoppers and refill them with water before returning to complete the street. If the sweeper has to maneuver around a parked car, the operator will attempt to return to the area later to complete the roadway.
