

World Hepatitis Day

WHEREAS approximately 204,000 Canadians are living with hepatitis C and over 250,000 people are living with hepatitis B;

AND WHEREAS people living with hepatitis B and C have an increased risk of developing cirrhosis, liver failure and related illnesses;

AND WHEREAS Ontario has over 110,000 people living with hepatitis B or C, both of which are slow and progressive diseases;

AND WHEREAS there are vaccines available for Hepatitis A and B; effective Hepatitis C treatment therapies can cure over 95% of cases;

AND WHEREAS World Hepatitis Day provides an opportunity to reach out to millions of Canadians and encourage hepatitis testing, provide treatment and care for those affected while paving the way towards elimination of hepatitis as a public health concern in Canada by 2030;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Town of Pelham hereby proclaims July 28, 2026 as World Hepatitis Day in the Town of Pelham.
